Care of St. Peter's Cemetery Lots

- Live (Fresh) Flowers may be placed in a concrete urn, at the side of the memorial stone. NO in-ground planting allowed. NO clay, plastic or wooden pots allowed.
- Live Shrubbery may be placed in a concrete urn only, at the side of the memorial stone, and is not to exceed 18 inches.
- Live (Fresh) Wreaths may be attached to the memorial stone by a proper holder (saddle).
- Flags for Veteran's and Societies are allowed Memorial Day through Labor Day.
- In the Shrine Section, Urns are allowed on flush markers (memorial stones) from Memorial day through Labor Day, at which time the urns must be removed by the lot owner.
- No animals are allowed in the Cemetery, and No dumping of any materials.
